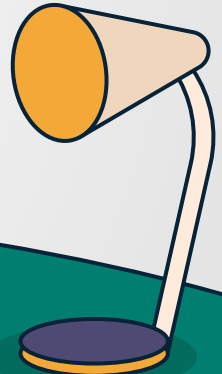
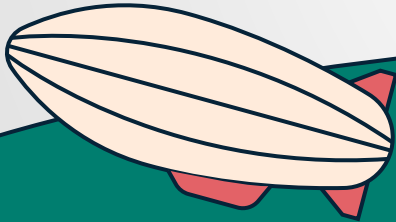
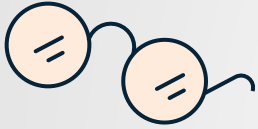

I'm too busy to volunteer.	I've got too much homework.	They've got too many things to do.

(not) enough + noun

I've got enough time.	I don't have enough time.

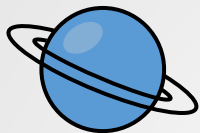
